### [Accredited Valuation Analyst - AVA](#)

The Accredited Valuation Analyst credential is awarded by the National Association of Certified Valuation Analysts (NACVA) and is available to non-CPAs.

It was established in 1976 by the International Foundation of Employee Benefit Plans and The Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. Nearly 10,000 individuals have already earned the designation and thousands more are actively in pursuit of it. To qualify, you must pursue one of three designations, Group Benefits Associate, Retirement Plan Associate or Compensation Management Specialist.

Professional designation awarded by the National Association of Certified Valuation Analysts for professionals rendering fraud deterrence and analytical forensic services.

### [Certified in Financial Management - CFM](#)
